The role includes:

teaching at bachelor, master and postgraduate levels, as well as supervising master's and doctoral theses. the candidate should be able to teach in French about two years after taking up the position.

The candidate will be expected to:

develop a fundamental, creative and high-quality line of research at the national and international level in his/her area of specialisation and to obtain external funding.

He/she will also be responsible for administrative and organisational tasks within the Department of Inorganic and Analytical Chemistry and the Faculty.

Requirements:

PhD in chemistry or equivalent qualification.

Major publications in international journals.

Starting date: July 1, 2025 or upon mutual agreement.

Applications, consisting of a letter of motivation, a detailed curriculum vitae including a list of publications, a copy of the highest diploma, a 5-page research plan and a list of references that may be contacted by the committee must be submitted **exclusively** online **before September 15, 2024** (23:59 Geneva time) on the University's website at <http://unige.ch/academ> where the advertisement can also be consulted.
