- Industrial: **700 euros HT**

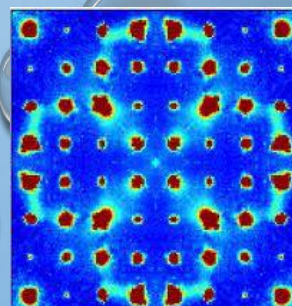
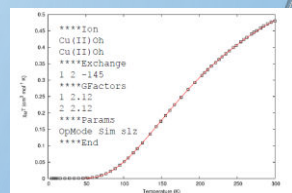
