

Both French-Nordic collaborative papers and papers from individual countries are welcome. These should lead to the identification of common scientific interests among researchers based in the Nordic countries (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, Sweden,) and France, which in turn **should foster future collaborations and exchange of ideas as well as mobility of young or senior researchers**.

We welcome short communications, full papers, and review articles. The deadline for the receipt of manuscripts is **September 1st, 2023** (no further extension), but early submissions would be much appreciated. Publication is provisionally scheduled for fall time.
